

3 TYPES OF COLLISIONS IN A CRASH ACCIDENT

In the case of a violent impact, three types of collisions occur immediately to which the occupants are subject:

VEHICLE COLLISION

The first collision occurs when the vehicle collides with another vehicle or obstacle. The vehicle deforms, decelerating rapidly until it stops.



OCCUPANT COLLISION

The second collision occurs when the vehicle stops and the occupants inside the vehicle continue moving towards the point of impact at the same speed and impact components inside the vehicle, airbag, steering wheel, windshield, etc.



INTERNAL COLLISION

The third collision occurs when the occupant's body stops and the internal organs continue moving towards the point of impact and collide with other organs or bones, which can cause internal injuries. (internal organs against the body's bony structure (skeleton)).
